Righteousness is revealed in the gospel, but wrath is revealed as an activity God takes to uphold his glory.} is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of people, who suppress the truth by their wickedness, {For the wickedness of humanity deliberately smothers the truth and keeps people from acknowledging the truth about God.}
