

Revelation Chapter 5:6-6:1

5.8 Jesus takes the scroll then there are 7 verses telling what happened in heaven as soon as the scroll is taken. Before the scroll is opened there is worship, because God never wants to give us knowledge without worship. 1Cor. 8:1 Now about food sacrificed to idols: We know that "We all possess knowledge." But knowledge puffs up while love builds up. <sup>2</sup> Those who think they know something do not yet know as they ought to know. <sup>3</sup> But whoever loves God is known by God.

They sing 3 songs. They have the prayers of the saints which will now be answered. What do they sing? "A new Song". OT told to sing a new song 7xs. 5.9 is a formula for Worship songs. 5.10 describes who is singing. The Church. Notice they say "on earth". Matt. 9:10 <sup>10</sup> your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Remember the 3 Rebellions; Satan, Angels, Man. 1<sup>st</sup> sings the Cherubs and Church, 2<sup>nd</sup> sings the Angels, third every creature in heaven, on earth and under earth.

5.11 Seven attributes of God. While this is happening in heaven, what is happening on earth? See Rev. 16:11 People gnawed their tongues in agony <sup>11</sup> and cursed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, but they refused to repent of what they had done.

3<sup>rd</sup> song is Creation (Babylon) singing praise. They sing 4 things: praise honor glory and power because 4 is the number of creation. See Gen. 2:10 <sup>10</sup> A river watering the garden flowed from Eden; from there it was separated into four headwaters.

5:14 the four creatures who start worship end it. Now Jesus has been given all things. Rev 6:1-2 Begins the most documented time in the Bible. So much is said about this that there is much confusion about how to interpret it. If this is the beginning of Daniel's final week, the first thing that happens is the Anti-Christ comes. See Daniel 8:23-26 <sup>23</sup> "In the latter part of their reign, when rebels have become completely wicked, a fierce-looking king, a master of intrigue, will arise. <sup>24</sup> He will become very strong, but not by his own power. He will cause astounding devastation and will succeed in whatever he does. He will destroy those who are mighty, the holy people. <sup>25</sup> He will cause deceit to prosper, and he will consider himself superior. When they feel secure, he will destroy many and take his stand against the Prince of princes. Yet he will be destroyed, but not by human power.

The last thing Daniel saw before the scroll was sealed was the Anti-Christ. Now the scroll is opened and the first thing that happens is the Anti-Christ.

6:1 who is the rider? Not Jesus, but the Anti-Christ. See Rev. 19: 11 <sup>11</sup> I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True.
